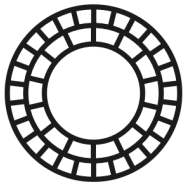


# The Ultimate iPhone Photos Editing Kit



## VSCO

This is the app I use every day for most of my edits. It has an impressive collection of filters, broken down by categories. My favorite ones are A6 from 'Analog' and HB1 from 'Hypebeast'. I also adjust Exposure and Contrast here.



## TOUCH RETOUCH

When it comes to removing unwanted elements from your photos, this is seriously a life-saving app. I remove dirt, spots and other disturbing stuff from my photos with a 'lasso' tool. It requires a little bit of practice to master the skill of removing objects quickly and neatly.



## SNAPSEED

I use this app when I need to tune up separate elements on the photo. For example, I only want to add contrast to one flower and that's where a 'Selective' edit option in Snapseed comes in handy. You can also adjust Exposure and Saturation selectively.



## AFTERLIGHT

I love Afterlight for 2 features: to crop a photo into different formats and to add borders. It allows to change the width of the border as much as you like it and this is something other apps are lacking.



## FACETUNE

This app is very popular for editing portraits (smoothing skin and fixing hair), I use it to whiten a background where necessary. It's perfect to get rid of the yellow effects in photos and I can't recommend this app enough.
